MRS. WILLIAM BEYER DIED SATURDAY MORNING, MAY 13, AT 1 O'CLOCK AT THE HOME OF HER DAUGHTER, MRS. ANNA HIRDLER, IN FOREST TOWNSHIP. FUNERAL SERVICES WERE HELD THIS AFTERNOON AT 1 O'CLOCK FROM THE HOME AND AT 2 O'CLOCK FROM THE CHURCH. BURIAL WAS MADE IN UNION CEMETERY IN FOREST. 18/MAY/1922---MRS. FREDRIKA BEYERS PASSED AWAY SATURDAY MORNING, MAY 13, AT 1 O'CLOCK AT THE HOME OF HER SON-IN-LAW AUGUST HIRDLER AFTER AN ILLNESS OF SEVERAL WEEKS, AT THE AGE OF 82 YEARS 11 MONTHS. SHE IS SURVIVED BY THREE SONS, HERMAN, WILLIAM AND FRED BEYERS AND FOUR DAUGHTERS, MRS. BRODNEER, MRS. AUGUST HIRDLER, MRS. FRED PRINZING AND MRS. CHARLES PRINZING. THE FUNERAL WAS HELD MONDAY AT 1 O'CLOCK AT THE HOME OF AUGUST HIRDLER AT 2 O'CLOCK FROM ST. JOHN'S CHURCH. BURIAL WAS IN ST. JOHN'S CEMETERY (GERMAN UNION CEMETERY). SIX GRANDSONS WERE THE PALLBEARERS.
