The funeral service for William DeMann was held Saturday afternoon, Oct. 11, at the Anderson Mortuary. Mr. DeMann died Wednesday noon, Oct. 8, 1958, at the St. Olaf Avenue Nursing Home. The Rev. Boral Biorn, pastor of St. John's Lutheran church where Mr. DeMann was a member, officiated. Miss Esther Boe sang. Burial was in Forest Union Cemetery. Pallbearers were Frank Smith, Arvid Johnson, Joe Trnka, Sever Dalby, Gilbert Dalby and Herbert Younker. Mr. DeMann was born May 25, 1891, in Forest township, the son of August and Anna (Hirdler) DeMann. He continued to live in Forest township all of his life, and as an adult was engaged in farming. He had been in failing health the past four or five years. Surviving Mr. DeMann were one brother, Arthur DeMann of Dundas, four sisters, Mrs. Edward Severson (Bertha) and Mrs. Gertrude Smisek of Faribault; Mrs. Alice Fick of Minneapolis and Mrs. Lucy Ernst of Northfield. 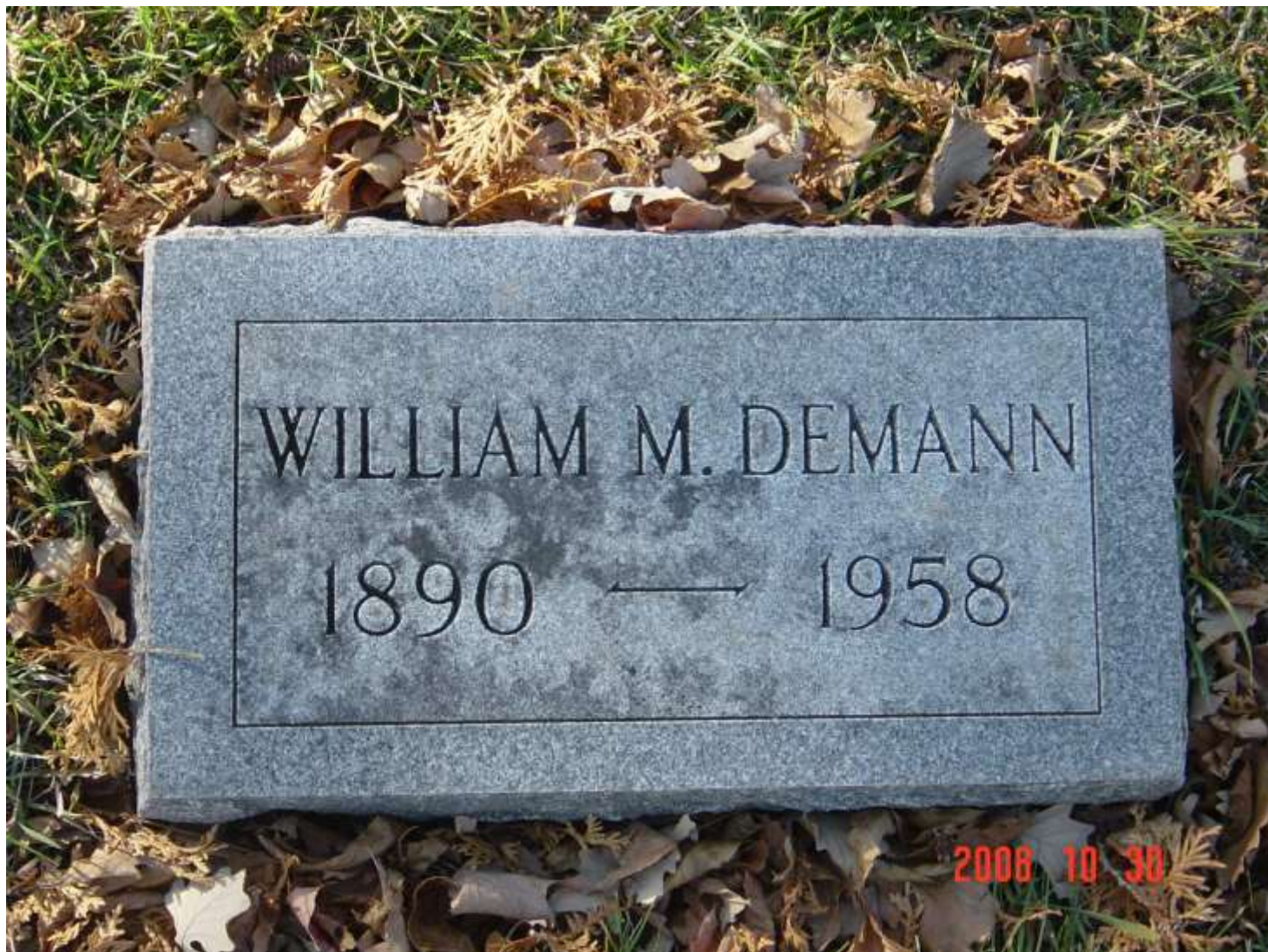
