George John Fischer, 76, of 311 N. Oxford St., Northfield, died Sunday at Northfield Hospital. Services will be Wednesday at Trinity Lutheran Church, Northfield, with the Rev. Edward Meyers officiating. Spring interment will be in German Union Cemetery. Friends may call at the Bierman Mortuary Tuesday from 2 until 9 p.m., Wednesday from 9 a. m. until noon and at the church one hour before services. He is survived by his widow, Hazel; on son, Duwayne of Faribault; two daughters, Mrs. Allen (Marcella) Ista and Mrs. Jerome (Phyllis) Kotz, both of Northfield; 12 grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a brother, two sisters, and three great-grandchildren. Mr. Fischer was employed in Faribault, retiring in 1964.

George John Fischer, 76, a long-time resident of the Northfield area, died for a massive heart attack at his home at 311 Manitou on Sunday, Jan. 11, 1976. He had suffered a stroke in March of 1969, losing the use of his right arm and leg, but he had improved considerably. Fischer was born April 10, 1899, in Forest township to Herman and Mary (Abel) Fischer. He grew up in Forest township west of Millersburg on the west shore of Circle Lake. He farmed with his brother for a time and they also hauled milk to the Northfield Condensary for nine years, 1926 to 1935. After moving to Northfield, he worked on the Minneapolis, Northfield and Southern railroad for some years, then for Northern States Power Co. for 20 years. He had a workshop at home and did much woodworking there. Among the things he made were Christmas decorations and the Fischers won prizes for their home outdoor Christmas decoration for several years. He was an active hunter and fisherman most of his life. In November, he would usually go to the woods near his daughter's home at Two harbors and hunt deer and ducks. But at home, he fed rabbits and squirrels and birds and watched over them very tenderly, according to his wife. He was married on January 16, 1923, at the Methodist parsonage to Hazel A. Schoen, who survives him. He is also survived by two daughters, Marcella Ista (Mrs Allen) and Phyllis Kotz (Mrs. Jerome), both of Northfield; a son; Duwayne, of Faribault; 12 grandchildren, Carole Amy (Mrs. Allen) of Mazeppa. Barbara Courneya (Mrs. Paul) of Bloomington, Kathy Swenson (Mrs. David) Northfield; Dawn Finstuen (Mrs. Lyle of Zumbrota, Linda Sterling (Mrs. Bruce) of Faribault, Diane Heffner (Mrs. David), of Minneapolis, Douglas Fischer of St. Paul, James Fischer of Waseca, Cheryl Hofard (Mrs. Greg) of Faribault, David Kotz, Daniel Kotz and John Fischer; eight great-grandchildren.
