Out-of-town relatives and friends who attended the funeral were from Osakis, Kasson, Wells, and Owatonna. Frank Schulz was born Mar. 16, 1895, in Forest Township. He attended the township school and lived there for his entire lifetime. He is survived by four sisters: Mrs. Julius Schlemmer of Muskegon, Mich., Mrs. Charles F. Anderson and Mrs. Joyce Petersmeyer of Faribault and Mrs. Arthur Hanna of Oak Park, Ill., and one brother, Albert Schulz of Knoxville, Ill.
