MR. WILLIAM PHILIP MEEHL DIED AT HIS HOME MONDAY, FEBRUARY 8, AT THE AGE OF 56 YEARS. HE WAS BORN JUNE 8, 1858, TO JACOB AND HENRIETTA PETER MEEHL, NEAR DURSHIRE, PA. AT THE AGE OF FOUR YEARS HE MOVED WITH HIS PARENTS TO THE TOWN OF FOREST, WHERE HE HAS SINCE MADE HIS HOME. HE WAS MARRIED IN 1883 TO CAROLNA VOSS, OF THE TOWN OF FOREST. TO THEIR UNION WAS BORN TEN CHILDREN. THEY ARE EDWARD, WILLIE, ARTHUR, HENRY, GOODWIN, ELIZABETH, ANNIE, THRESSA, AND TWINS, CLARA AND CORA, ALL OF WHOM ARE LIVING. MRS. MEEHL PASSED AWAY ELEVEN YEARS AGO. DEATH CAME UNEXPECTEDLY TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY AND COMMUNITY. IN EARLY YEARS HE GAVE HIS HEART TO GOD AND WAS BAPTIZED AND TRIED HARD TO LIVE AND BE FAITHFUL TO HIS MASTER.

BOOK - RICE COUNTY FAMILIES. PUB. 1981 William P. Meehl Family. William P. Meehl, son of Jacob and Henrietta Peters Meehl, was born June 8, 1858, in Sullivan County, PA. In 1863 he came with his family to Forest Township, Rice County, where they homesteaded. In 1883 he was married to Caroline Voss (Vohs) of Forest Township. William and Caroline had 10 children: Edward, William, Arthur, henry, Goodwin, Elizabeth, Anne and Threasa (twins) Clara and Cora (twins). All are now deceased except Anne, Clara and Cora. Anne married Alfred Verdick and lives in Jackson, MN, for some years. They had 1 daughter, Ardith Potter, who passed away at the age of 28. She had 4 sons, Greg, Tim (who is a doctor), Scott and Joel. Elizabeth lived in Chicago, married and had 3 daughters. Threasa moved to Wyoming when young, was a schoolteacher, married and had 1 son. Clara and Cora also moved to Wyoming and taught school. Clara married a Wilkenson, had 3 children, 1 of whom survives, namely Glen. Cora married Irl Brown, has 1 daughter, Carol. Edward married Marie Paulson, they had 2 children, LaVern and Doris. William married Clara Paulson. They had 2 daughters, Grace and Margaret. Grace passed away in 1974. Arthur married Johanna Paulson, they had 3 children, Harlan, Bernice and Geraldine, all of whom are still living. It might be interesting to note that 3 brothers married 3 sisters. Goodwin married Mabel Mosher. They had 6 children, Elinor, Clifford, Donald, Charles, Donna and Patsy, all of whom survive. Henry married Sadie Johnson. They had 2 children, Lloyd and Irene Meehl Searle, who are still living. Caroline died at the early age of 38. Her 4 youngest were twins, ages 2 and 4. William Meehl built a beautiful 3story home that was a showplace of that era for his 10 children, all the interior being black walnut grown on his farm. He donated lumber and helped built the St. John's (German) Church near their home in Forest Township. He was a prominent, kind, well-liked man in the community. Information from a book on file in the Library at Washington states he was a Republican, a prominent member of the Baptist church, served on the town board and school board in Rice County. He passed away in 1915 at the age of 56 years form a heart attack.
