SEXTON: It is unlawful for any sexton, or other person in charge of a burial place, to permit burial or other disposition of a dead body before a burial-transit permit is deposited with him. (The sexton may accept the permit of any state or of the District of Columbia, as authorization for burial.)

All permits must be endorsed and retained permanently in your files.

PENALTY for violations is from \$20 to \$200 for each offense.

QUARANTINABLE DISEASES are epidemic meningitis; cholera (Asiatic); diphtheria; infantile paralysis; plague; scarlet fever; smallpox; typhus fever and yellow fever.
