Funeral services for Mrs. Karl Mielke, who died at Ray, Minnesota last Friday, Sept. 19th., were held Monday afternoon at the home of her son Frank Mielke in Forest. The funeral started from the home at 1 o'clock and services were held at the Forest church at 2 o'clock. Rev. Schultz of Faribault officiated at the services. Interment was made in St. John's Union cemetery. Johanna Rodke was born in Kuckmuehle, Prussia, June 24, 1843. She was married 57 years ago to Karl Mielke. Five years later they came to Faribault, from Germany and made their home in Forest town. She leaves to mourn her death one daughter, Mrs. Frank Greenwald of Ray, Minn.; and four sons Will, of Ray, Minn.; Frank of Forest, and Charles and August of Danville, Ill. The youngest son George, preceded her in death two years ago last March. The surviving sons and daughters were present at the funeral.
