Funeral services were held for Mrs. Sophia Remick on May 27 from St. John's Lutheran church in Forest township at two o'clock. Rev. R. H. Hill officiated at the service, and interment was made in German Union Cemetery. The pallbearers were six nephews of the deceased, George Stehly, Gust Demann, Ernest Demann, Henry Wille and Henry Demann. Mrs. Sophie Remick was born, March 27, 1865 in the town of Forest. She was united in marriage to Henry Remick in December 1891. To this union six children were born, five of whom she leaves to mourn; Henry of St. Paul, George, Fred and William of Forest, and Mrs. Lee Olinger of St. Paul. One son and her husband preceded her in death. Three brothers, William of Forest, Charles of Faribault, and August of Farmington, and one sister, Mrs. John Benson of Frederic, Wis., also survive.
