Milo Eugene Searle FARIBAULT -- Milo Eugene "Gene" Searle, 83, of Faribault, died Friday, October 4, 2002 at his home. Memorial services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday at First English Lutheran Church, Faribault with the Rev. Meredith Bedker Musaus officiating. Burial will be in German Union Cemetery, Millersburg. Visitation is scheduled for 2-4 p.m. Sunday at the Boldt Funeral Home, Faribault and at the church for one hour prior to the service on Monday. Veteran's military rites will be provided at the church by the Central Veterans Association. Gene, the son of Alfred and Mabel (Wheeler) Searle was born May 13, 1919 in Haywarden, Iowa. He served five years in the Pacific Theater of World War II with the U.S. Army. He was a retired letter carrier having served 35 years in Faribault. He was a past President of First English Lutheran Church, a member and former treasurer of the Association of Federal Retirees, a former member of the VFW Post #1562, and was a Faribault Daily News 1997 Unsung Hero. He is survived by his wife, Irene of Faribault; two daughters, Sandra (and Paul) Cook of Eagan, and Linda (and Scott) Gerr of Faribault; three grandsons; and a brother, Wayne (and Eilene) Searle of Rochester. He was preceded in death by his parents and a grandson, Daniel Hacker.
