Pallbearers were Paul Fahey, Edwin Gustafson, Lawrence Gustafson, Henry Ludwig, Donald Rodewald and Howard Sanford. Interment was in the German Union cemetery in Forest township. Mr. Eng was born in Forest township on January 2, 1915, the son of Ole and Anna Eng. On January 22, 1937, he married the former Verna Shaw at Dundas. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran church in Northfield.
