John Evert was born Jan. 1, 1876 to John and Louise Evert in Minnesota. He farmed in Forest township for many years. He passed away suddenly Sunday, Nov. 13, in the Rice county District I Hospital. **BOOK - HISTORY OF RICE & STEELE COUNTIES VOL I & II 1910.** John Evert was born in Forest township, Rice county, Minnesota, January 1, 1876. He is a son of John and Louise Evert, both natives of Germany, who came to America in the later sixties and located first at Dundas; they worked there for about five years and then bought a farm in Forest township, where the father did general farming until about the year 1904, when he retired from active work, renting the farm to his son, who has since carried it on. The mother died in the year 1880. John Evert attended the district school in Forest, and after leaving school he worked on the farm with his father, until he rented it from his father and commenced work for himself in 1904. He has five brothers and sisters: Henrietta Shultz, Louise Siemers, Gottlieb, now deceased, Charles, who lives at Faribault. In politics he is an independent voter, and in his religious belief he is a Lutheran.
