NORTHFIELD--Funeral services for Herman Fischer, aged Northfield resident, who was killed when he was hit by a car Monday evening, May 5, were held Thursday afternoon at 2:00 p.m. in the Bierman Funeral chapel. The Rev. Richard Douglas, pastor of the Methodist church, officiated. Burial was made in St. John's cemetery, Forest township. Pallbearers were Duwayne Fischer, Harold Dalby, Leonard Dalby, Bernard Dalby, Allen Ista and Iver Johnson. Herman was born March 4, 1864 at Madison, Wis. As a young man he came to Rice county where he was married in 1893 to Mary Abel. The couple engaged in farming on the Abel farm on the west side of Circle Lake. They made their home there until the death of Mrs. Fischer in 1931. Besides farming, Mr. Fischer also engaged in horseshoeing and threshing. Mr. and Mrs. Fischer were the parents of five children, Mrs. Gilbert Dalby (Annie) of Forest township; Herman Fischer, Dundas; Sever Dalby (Laura) also of Forest and George Fischer of Northfield, with whom Mr. Fischer had made his home for the past many years. One daughter, Mary died as a child.
