Funeral services for Mrs. Mary Fischer, who passed away July 22, 1931 were held at St. John's church on Friday afternoon at Millersburg. Interment was made in the church cemetery. Mrs. Mary Fischer passed away at the home of her daughters Mrs. Gilbert Dalby Wednesday afternoon July 22, at 2:30 at the age of 62 years. She had been in failing health for about two years and was under medical care most of that time. Mrs. Fischer was born Feb. 20, 1869 in Bridgewater in Rice county. At the age of four years she moved with her parents to the old homestead. She spent her youth and young womanhood here and in 1893 was united in marriage to Herman Fischer. To this union five children were born, all of whom survive except one daughter, Mary, who died twenty-five years ago at the age of three years. Mrs. Fischer is survived by her husband, Herman Fischer, two daughters, Mrs. Gilbert Dalby and Mrs. Sever Dalby of Millersburg, two sons who live at home, Herman and George and three sisters, Mrs. Thomas Dougherty, Mrs. Julius Wadekamper and Mrs. William Beyer, many grandchildren, nieces, nephews and friends also mourn her death. Funeral services were conducted by Rev. Harry Hill. Pallbearers were Leonard and Bernard Dalby, Thomas Walstad, John Dougherty, John and Henry Wadekamper.
