CARL MIELKE AN OLD RESIDENT OF THE TOWN OF FOREST PASSED AWAY TUESDAY JAN. 25, AFTER AN ILLNESS OF TWO WEEKS AT THE AGE OF 79 YEARS. HE WAS BORN IN GERMANY, MAY 5, 1841. HE LEAVES TO MOURN HIS LOSS HIS WIFE AND FIVE SONS, WILLIAM AND GEORGE OF RAY, MINN., CHARLES AND AUGUST OF DANVILLE, ILL., FRANK OF CIRCLE LAKE AND ONE DAUGHTER, MRS. F. GREENWOLD OF RAY, MINN. THE FUNERAL WAS HELD FROM THE RESIDENCE THEN AT ST. JOHN'S CHURCH, FRIDAY AT 1 O'CLOCK. INTERMENT WAS MADE IN ST. JOHN'S CEMETERY, REV. WEINOLD OF WEBSTER OFFICIATING.

Fine or imprisonment for receiving a body for burial without permit.
