She attended school in District 66, and resided during her entire lifetime in Forest township. On July 27, 1914 she was married to Ole Eng who died on Nov. 3, 1914. She was married again on May 28, 1918, to Jacob Prinzing. They established their home on the Forest township farm on which they had since lived. Mrs. Prinzing was a member of Trinity church and an honorary member if its Ladies' Aid society. She is survived by her husband; a daughter, Mrs. Cecil Hutton (Marion) of Dundas; two sons, Emmanuel Eng of Dundas and Raymond Prinzing of Forest township; and ten grandchildren. One grandchild, five brothers and three sisters preceded her in death.
