Funeral services for Mrs. Frederick Prinzing, 86, of 617 NW Seventh St., Faribault and formerly of Forest Township, who passed away on Friday afternoon, August 20, at the Wood's Nursing Home, following a brief illness, were held on Monday, August 23, at 10:30 a.m., at the Trinity Lutheran Church of Faribault, with the Rev. Robert H. Sorenson officiating. G. H. Prigge was the organist who provided the appropriate music. Pallbearers were Irvin Jenö, Luverne Jenö, Norman and Reuben Prinzing and Alvin and Arnold Wadekamper. Interment was in St. John's Cemetery in Forest Township. Martha Beyer was born on July 28, 1879, at Bremerhaven, Germany, to William and Fredericka Buse Beyer, who preceded her in death. She was wed on August 30, 1905, at Faribault, to Frederick Prinzing, who survives her. She was a member of the Trinity Lutheran church. Mrs. Prinzing is survived by: her husband; two daughters, Mrs. Eugene (Pearl) Jenö of Bixby, and Mrs. Elsie Wadekamper of Faribault; two sons, Herbert of Elysian and George of Cannon Falls; 25 grandchildren and 28 great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, three sisters and four brothers.
