Funeral services were held for Mrs. Mary Prinzing Friday, Feb. 17, at 2 p. m. at the Boldt Funeral Home at Faribault. The Rev. Kenneth Worthman officiated. Mrs. Gene Severson sang "Be Still My Soul" and "What A Friend We Have In Jesus." She was accompanied on the organ by Mrs. Lester Nichols. Pallbearers were Alfred Barfknecht, Hans Christensen, Thomas Walstad, Raymond Prinzing, Alvin Wadekamper and George Prinzing. Mrs. Prinzing died at the Rice County District One Hospital at Faribault Tuesday, Feb. 14, following an extended illness. She was 80 years of age at the time of her death. Mary Beyer Prinzing, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Beyer, was born Dec. 23, 1880, at Bremerhaven, Germany. She was married to Charles Prinzing in November, 1903, in Forest Township. For the past 40 years she has resided in Faribault. She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Robert Boll (Cecilia) of Plattville, Wis.; two sons, Roland of Faribault and Henry of Albert Lea; one grandson, Ronald Prinzing of Faribault and one sister, Mrs. Fred Prinzing of Faribault. Relatives and friends attending the services from out of town were from Platteville, Wis.; Kasson, Minneapolis, St. Paul, Northfield, Webster, Lonsdale, Albert Lea, Dundas and Mankato.
