HENRY REMICK, A PROMINENT FARMER OF FOREST TOWNSHIP, PASSED AWAY THIS MORNING AT 1 O'CLOCK AFTER AN ILLNESS OF OVER A YEAR, THE LAST FIVE MONTHS OF WHICH WERE SPENT IN CONFINEMENT TO HIS BED. DEATH WAS DUE TO A COMPLICATION OF DISEASES. HENRY REMICK WAS BORN DEC. 11, 1859, IN OHIO, WHERE HE SPENT HIS EARLY BOYHOOD DAYS. WHEN YET A SMALL BOY HE CAME WITH HIS PARENTS TO MINNESOTA, SETTLING ON A FARM IN ERIN TOWNSHIP, IN THIS COUNTY, WHERE HE GREW TO MANHOOD. ON DEC. 22, 1890, HE WAS UNITED IN MARRIAGE TO SOPHIA DEMANN, THE MARRIAGE CEREMONY BEING PERFORMED IN FARIBAULT. TO THIS UNION SIX CHILDREN WERE BORN, ONE OF THEM DYING IN INFANCY. HE IS SURVIVED BY HIS WIFE AND FIVE CHILDREN, FOUR OF THEM MAKING THEIR HOMES IN RICE COUNTY. GEORGE REMICK AND HENRY REMICK RESIDE IN FOREST TOWNSHIP, WILLIAM AND FRED ARE AT HOME AND MRS. LEE OLINGER RESIDES AT CASTLE ROCK. MR. REMICK LEAVES THREE BROTHERS AND FOUR SISTER: JOSEPH REMICK OF HIBBING, MINN., GEORGE REMICK OF RED LAKE FALLS, MINN., JOHN REMICK OF CROOKSTON, MINN., MRS. CHARLES WILLE OF HAMPTON, MINN., MRS. CHARLES DEMANN AND MRS. CHARLES EVERETT OF FOREST TOWNSHIP, AND MRS. KATHERINE STEHLY OF THIS CITY. THE FUNERAL WILL TAKE PLACE SATURDAY AFTERNOON AT 1 O'CLOCK FROM THE FAMILY HOME AND AT 2 O'CLOCK FROM ST. JOHN'S CHURCH IN FOREST TOWNSHIP, AND BURIAL WILL BE MADE IN UNION CEMETERY. BIOGRAPHY

BOOK - HISTORY OF RICE & STEELE COUNTIES VOL I & II 1910. Henry Remick was born in Harting county, Ohio, December 11, 1859. He is a son of Joseph and Elizabeth Remick, natives of Germany. They came to America in the forties and located in Ohio, where the father worked out on a farm. In 1867 he came to Minnesota, and settled in Erin township, Rice county, and farmed there until 1907, when he sold his farm and bought in Forest township, where he now lives. Mrs. Remick died in February, 1901. Mr. Remick attended the public schools in Shieldsville, and after leaving school worked on a farm. In 1887 he bought 107 acres in section 18, and later eighty acres in section 20. He now lives on section 18 and does general farming. He was married in 1890, to Sophia Deman, a daughter of Christian and Johanna Deman, the parents being natives of Germany who emigrated to this country. Five children have blessed the home of Mr. and Mrs. Remick: Henry, George, Fred, Mary and William. Mr. Remick is a member of the Lutheran
