Services for Mrs. John Ross, 77, were held Sunday, February 3, at 2 p.m. at Trinity Lutheran church, with the Rev. Lawrence Gallman of Peace Lutheran church officiating. Mrs. Ross died Thursday, January 31, at the home of her son and daughter-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. William Ross of Forest township, after a brief illness. At the service Miss Serena and Miss Gretchen Kirsch sang "Asleep In Jesus." Interment was made in St. John's cemetery at Forest. Pallbearers were all grandsons of the deceased, Maynard, Harold, Roger, Robert, Donald, and Lloyd Ross. Mrs. Ross (nee Anna Dodes) was born October 27, 1874, in Webster township. She was baptized, confirmed, and married there. Her marriage to John Ross took place March 20, 1900. For the last 52 years of her life she lived in Forest. Mrs. Ross was a member of Peace Lutheran church. Surviving are three sons, William, Henry and Aaron, all of Faribault; one daughter, Mrs. Ebert Halverson (Luella) of Forest; 10 grandchildren; and two brothers, Ferdinand of Forest and Fred of Faribault. Her husband died October 25, 1943, and two of her sons also preceded her in death. Relatives and friends attended the funeral from St. Paul, South St. Paul, St. Louis Park, Red Wing, Webster, Pemberton, Farmington, Castle Rock, Northfield, Hampton, Lakeville, Morristown, Waterville, Dundas, and Minneapolis.
