Funeral services were held for John Ross on Thursday afternoon, October 28 at 1:30 from the family home and at 2:00 p.m. from St. John's Lutheran church in Forest township with Rev. Walter Beltz officiating. Interment was made in Union cemetery. Six nephews were the pallbearers including Henry Weise, Daniel Weise, Paul Meinke, Henry Dodes, Clarence Dodes and Delmer Gusse. John Frederick Ross, son of Henry and Wilhelmina Fram Ross was born December 11, 1876 in Niagara county, N.Y., and came to this community when he was two years of age. He was confirmed on March 22, 1891 by the late Pastor H. Schultz. On March 20, 1900 he was united in marriage to Anna Dodes. To this marriage was born six children, five sons and one daughter. He is survived by his wife and three sons, William, Henry and Aaron, and his daughter, Luella, Mrs. Ebert Halvorson. Two sons, George and John, have preceded their father in death. Mr. Ross died on Monday, October 25 at the Northfield hospital following an illness which has extended over several months. Mr. Ross held many church and civic offices during his long residence in Forest township. He served as church elder at St. John's congregation. He served as town clerk for six years; assessor for 18 years and supervisor for 15 years. He was an ardent supporter of farmer cooperation and of the Forest creamery, where he was a member of the board of directors for many years. Many friends from the local community and far away attended the funeral services.

BOOK - RICE COUNTY FAMILIES, PUB. 1981 John Frederick Ross Family. Henry and Wilhelmina (Fram) Ross arrived in Niagara County, New York, from Hamburg, Germany. Their first son, John, was born in new York, December 11, 1876. Less than 2 years later Henry, Wilhelmine, baby John and Gottlieb Fram (Wilhelmine's father) moved to Forest Township, Rice County, MN. Five more children were born after they arrived in Forest Township. John married Anna Dodes on March 20, 1900. His sisters were Mary who married Fred Dodes; Emma married Ferdinand Dodes; Henrietta married William Gusse. His brothers, Joseph and Henry, passed away as children. Mary, Emma and Henrietta, with their husbands, farmed in the Webster area of Rice County. John and his wife, Anna, remained on the home place with John's father. John's mother passed away in 1895 and his father, Henry, on February 1, 1931, at the age of 84. John and Anna had 6 children. William married Bernice Olesen of Hazelwood, May 7, 1929; Henry married Lillian Nelsen of Farmington, June 4, 1930; Aaron married Emma Schmidtke of the North Morristown area on June 4, 1931; and the youngest, Luella, married Ebert Halvorson of Forest Township on November 4, 1936. George, the 3rd son, passed away at age 19 in 1925 and John Jr., the 5th son, passed away at age 13 in 1927. John Sr. passed away October 25, 1943, and Anna, January 31, 1952. The 3 sons lived on and farmed adjacent farms. William and Bernice had 3 sons--Roger, Robert and Allen, all who farm in Forest Township. Henry and Lillian had 2 boys, Donald and Lloyd, both still farming in Forest Township. Lillian passed away in 1966, Henry in 1977. Aaron and Emma had 5 children: Lorraine Nelson, now Rice County Auditor in Faribault; Maynard, farming in Forest Township; Harold, a pastor presently of Elgin, IL; Lyle a farmer and farm dealer living in Forest Township and Dorothy Britz, a business teacher in Burnsville. Aaron passed away in 1971. Luella and Ebert Halvorson farmed for many years in Forest Township and now reside in Faribault. The home farm in section 18 of Forest Township where Henry and Wilhelmine first settled in 1878 is now owned and operated by Allen Ross, William's youngest son--the 4th generation of Ross ownership, now over 100 years. William and Bernice Ross (John's oldest son) had farmed the home place and they still reside in the original home. Allen and his wife (Kathleen Lagerstrom) built their home on the same 80-acre tract. Their family is the 5th generation to occupy the farm.
