A VERDICT OF ACCIDENTAL SUICIDE WAS RETURNED YESTERDAY BY CORONOR C. A. INGERSON OF ST. PAUL, WHO CONDUCTED AN INVESTIGATION OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE DEATH OF FRED SIEMERS, FARIBAULT FARMER. MR. SIEMERS WAS FOUND DEAD IN HIS ROOM AT THE CHARLES BAUMANN HOME WHERE HE WAS STAYING. INVESTIGATIONS OF THE CASE SHOWED THAT THE GAS JET HAD BEEN PARTLY CLOSED. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE OLD MAN ATTEMPTED TO TURN OFF THE GAS, AND SUCCEEDED PARTIALLY. HE WAS IN A VERY SMALL ROOM, AND THIS FACT IS BELIEVED TO HAVE CAUSED HIS DEATH AS IT TOOK ONLY A SMALL AMOUNT OF GAS TO FILL IT. FRANK J. McCARTHY ACCOMPANIED RELATIVES OF THE DECEASED MAN TO ST. PAUL YESTERDAY AND BROUGHT THE BODY BACK FOR BURIAL. IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE FUNERAL SERVICES WILL BE HELD THURSDAY AFTERNOON AT 1 O'CLOCK AT THE HOME OF ALBERT FAVRO AND AT 2 O'CLOCK AT THE IMMANUEL LUTHERAN CHURCH AT FOREST. REV. SCHULZ OF FARIBAULT WILL OFFICIATE. MR. SIEMERS, WHO IS NOT MARRIED, HAS FOR THE PAST THREE YEARS MADE HIS HOME WITH THE WILLIAM KAMPF FAMILY HERE. HE IS SURVIVED BY THREE SISTERS AND FOUR BROTHERS. THE BROTHERS ARE HENRY AND DEDIE SIEMERS OF FARIBAULT, WILLIAM SIEMERS OF OAK PARK, MINN., AND JOSEPH SIEMERS OF FOREST. THE SISTERS ARE MRS. ALBERT FAVRO OF FARIBAULT. MRS. JOSEPH LAPESKA AND MRS. JACOB PRINGING. 19/OCT/1923--NEWS HAS JUST BEEN RECEIVED FROM ST. PAUL THAT FRED SIEMERS WAS FOUND DEAD IN HIS ROOM MONDAY MORNING, OCTOBER 15. THE FUNERAL WILL BE HELD AT ST. JOHN'S CHURCH HERE AT 2 O'CLOCK THURSDAY AFTERNOON. HE HAS BEEN A RESIDENT OF THIS COMMUNITY ALL HIS LIFE AND OWNED A FARM A LITTLE SOUTH OF ST. JOHN'S CHURCH. PARENTS OF DECEASED WERE HENRY AND MARGARET MEYER SIEMERS.
