WORD WAS RECEIVED TODAY BY A. A. MURPHY, UNDERTAKER AT McCARTHY'S UNDERTAKING PARLORS, THAT THE REMAINS OF THE LATE THEODORE WEDEKAMPER, WHO WAS ACCIDENTLY KILLED IN A LUMBER CAMP NEAR GRAND RAPIDS, HAD BEEN SHIPPED TO NORTHFIELD AND WOULD ARRIVE THERE TODAY, ACCOMPANIED BY TWO BROTHERS OF THE DECEASED WHO HAVE ALSO BEEN AT WORK IN THE NORTHERN WOODS. THE REMAINS WILL BE BROUGHT TO THE CITY TONIGHT AND THEY WILL BE ACCOMPANIED BY JOHN KEENAN, A SON-IN-LAW. THE FUNERAL WILL BE HELD TODAY FROM THE CHURCH OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION AND THE REMAINS WILL BE INTERRED IN CALVARY CEMETERY.

THE REMAINS OF THEODORE WEDEKAMPER, WHO WAS ACCIDENTLY KILLED SATURDAY LAST, JAN. 22, IN A LOGGING CAMP NEAR GRAND RAPIDS, MINNESOTA, ARRIVED AT NORTHFIELD YESTERDAY ACCOMPANIED BY HIS BROTHERS, VICTOR, OF MENTOR, MINN., AND LOUIS, OF BAGLEY, MINN. THEODORE WAS FORTY-TWO YEARS OF AGE. HE WAS BORN IN THE TOWN OF ERIN AND RESIDED THERE UNTIL EIGHT YEARS AGO. SINCE THEN HE HAS LIVED MOST OF THE TIME IN THE WESTERN PART OF THIS STATE. LAST FALL HE WENT TO GRAND RAPIDS TO WORK DURING THE WINTER IN THE PINE WOODS LUMBERING. HE WAS AN HONEST INDUSTRIOUS MAN AND HIS UNTIMELY DEATH IS REGRETTEED BY ALL WHO KNEW HIM. HE NEVER MARRIED BUT IS MOURNED BY FIVE BROTHERS, JULIUS, OF THE TOWN OF ERIN, WILLIAM AND RUDOLPH WHO RESIDE IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON AND THE TWO BROTHER ABOVE MENTIONED.
