Albert O. Wharton, 80, veteran of the War of the Rebellion and for many years a resident of Faribault, passed away at the Minnesota Soldiers' Home in St. Paul at 2:55 yesterday afternoon. The body will be brought to Faribault for burial and funeral services will be held at the Cathedral of Our Merciful Saviour Monday afternoon at 1:30, Dean W. C. Hengen officiating. From Monday morning until the hour of the funeral services the body of Mr. Wharton will lie in state at the Lenmark Funeral Home. Albert O. Wharton was born Dec. 24, 1845, at Newark, N. J. He came to Faribault from Kansas fifty-one years ago. In 1862 he enlisted at New Ulm, Minn., serving until 1865 when he received his honorable discharge at Fort Snelling. He served two years in the War of the Rebellion and one year in the regular army. He was married to Susan Frances Johnson of Alhambra, Wabaumza county, Kansas, on April 28, 1874. To this union nine children were born, eight of whom survive, one having died in infancy. The children who survive their father are Mrs. L. E. Kern, Forest township; Mrs. Bertha Remick, Faribault; Walter O. Wharton, St. Paul; Florence C. Venero, Faribault; Mrs. Mabel R. Thoen, St. Paul; Erwin J. Wharton, St. Paul; Mrs. Gertrude F. Harnden, Des Moines, Iowa, and Albert A. Wharton, St. Paul. Mrs. Wharton died seventeen years ago last Sept. 5 at St. Paul. Burial will be made in St. John's Union cemetery in the township of Forest, Rice county.

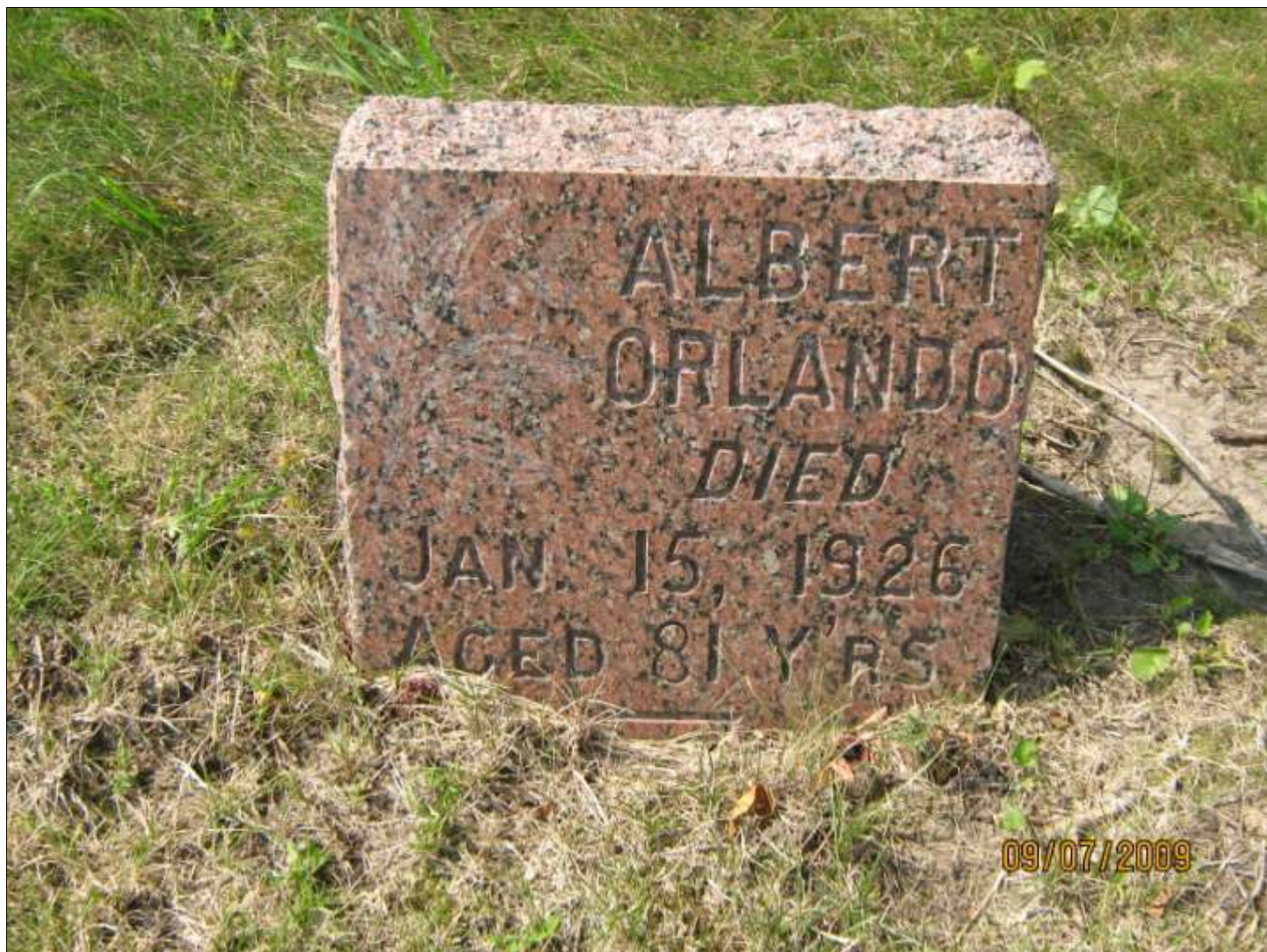
