MRS. SUSAN FRANCES WHARTON, WIFE OF ALBERT O. WHARTON, OF BRUNO, MINN., AND FORMERLY OF RICE COUNTY, DIED VERY SUDDENLY SEPTEMBER 5TH OF APOPLEXY. MRS. WHARTON WAS THE GUEST OF HER DAUGHTER IN ST. ANTHONY FALLS AND HAD BEEN ATTENDING THE FAIR. SHE WAS IN HER USUAL HEALTH UNTIL THE DAY BEFORE HER DEATH WHEN SHE COMPLAINED OF NAUSEA. NOTHING SERIOUS WAS THOT OF THIS. THE NEXT MORNING SHE WAS FOUND DEAD IN THE BATH ROOM. MRS. WHARTON WAS 58 YEARS, 3 MONTHS, OF AGE AND IS SURVIVED BY HER HUSBAND AND EIGHT CHILDREN; MRS. ALICE KERN OF FOX LAKE, MRS. BERTHA REMICK OF BRUNO, WALTER WHARTON OF ATLANTIC CITY, IOWA, MRS. FLORENCE VENERO OF FARIBAULT, MRS. MABEL THOEN OF MINNEAPOLIS, MISS GERTRUDE, EDWIN J., ALBERT A., WHO RESIDE AT HOME. MRS. WHARTON WAS A MEMBER OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH AND AN EARNEST WORKER. SHE WAS A KIND AND LOVING WIFE AND MOTHER AND GREATLY BELOVED BY ALL WHO KNEW HER. THE REMAINS WERE BROUGHT FROM MINNEAPOLIS TO DUNDAS AND THE FUNERAL WAS HELD FROM THE FOREST AND THE INTERMENT WAS IN THE FOREST CEMETERY, REV. STRIES OF DUNDAS OFFICIATING. MANY BEAUTIFUL FLORAL OFFERINGS BORE TESTIMONY OF THE LOVE AND ESTEEM IN WHICH SHE WAS HELD. AMONG THE OFFERINGS WAS A BEAUTIFUL WREATH WITH THE WORDS "BRUNO FRIENDS", WHICH CAME FROM THE LADIES' AID SOCIETY OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH.
